- 4.0 The submission of documents is deemed as undertaking by bidder that all the documents are true and genuine. If it is found at any time during bidding, execution of work or after completion of work that the information/documents submitted by the bidder are in variance of original/forged/bogus, they shall be legally held responsible for the same. Their offer shall be summarily rejected or termination of contract if awarded, action as per bid security declaration, forfeiture of performance guarantees, security deposit, if

any. **The bidder/contractor shall be blacklisted /debarred for further works in BSNL Electrical Zone Himachal for a period of three years.**

No claim whatsoever on such account shall be entertained by the BSNL in any circumstances.

The time allowed for carrying out the work will be Fifteen days.

After verification of the contents of Envelope-I, then 2nd Envelop containing the bid document shall be opened. If the Envelope-I in not annexed or the documents submitted in the Envelope-I are found incomplete or not in proper form against requirements as given below herein, then Envelope-2 containing price bid will not be opened at all and shall be returned to the tenderer on spot, if the tenderer is present at the time of tender opening.

i) **Performance Guarantee:** The contractor is required to furnish performance guarantee for an amount equal to 5% of the contract value in the form of CDR/FDR/DD or Bank guarantee (of a nationalized / Scheduled Bank in a standard format **Annexure-II**) within two weeks from the date of issue of award letter. This period can be further extended by the Engineer-in-charge up to a maximum period of 2 weeks on written request of Contractor. The validity period of the performance security in the form of bank guarantee shall be two years and three months from the date of award of work.

ii) **Security deposit:** In addition to performance guarantee stated above, a sum @ 10% of the gross amount of the bill shall be deducted from each running bill of the contractor till the sum be deducted with the sum already deposited as performance guarantee, will amount to security deposit of 10% of the Tendered value of the work.

08 The acceptance of a tender will rest with the Executive Engineer (E) BSNL Electrical Division, Shimla who does not bind himself to accept the lowest tender or any other tender and reserves to himself the Authority to reject lowest or all the tenders received without assigning any reason. All tenders in whom any of the prescribed conditions are not fulfilled or incomplete in any respect are liable to be rejected. **Tenders with any condition including that of conditional rebates shall be rejected forthwith summarily.**

09 Canvassing in connection with tender is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable for rejection.

11. The BSNL reserves itself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the tender and the tenderer shall be bound to perform the same at the rates quoted.

12. No employee in BSNL/ Govt. of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of two years of his retirement from service without the prior permission. The contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found at any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission as aforesaid before submission of tender and engagement in the contractor's service.

13. The tender for the works shall not be witnessed by the contractor who himself/themselves has/ have tendered or who may and has/have tender for the same

- work. Failure to observe this condition would render tenders of the contractors tendering as witnessing the tender is/are liable for summarily rejection.
14. The tenders for the work shall remain open for acceptance for a period of 90 days from the date of opening of the tenders.
If any tenderer withdraws his tender before the above said period or makes any modification in the terms and conditions of the tender which is not acceptable to the BSNL shall, without prejudice to any other right of remedy be at liberty to take action as per bid security declaration and further he will not be allowed to participate in tender for the same work on further calls. .
 15. **Extension of validity:** In case the letter of award of work cannot be placed within the validity period of the tender, the BSNL can request all tenderer to extend the validity of their respective tenders for a reasonable period. While BSNL can make the request for extension, the tenderer is free to either extend the validity or refuse the request to extend the validity.
 16. The contractor should read the tender documents carefully before submitting the tender.
 17. Agreement shall be drawn with the successful tenderer on prescribed form. Tenderer shall quote his rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form, which will form part of the agreement.
 18. This Notice Inviting Tender shall form part of the Contract document. The successful tenderer/contractor on acceptance of his tender by the Accepting authority, shall, within 15 days from the stipulated date of start of the work, sign the contract consisting of :-

The agencies who claim to be exempted from ESI registration should submit an affidavit on judicial stamp paper for the same.
 21. The near relatives of any BSNL Employee either directly recruited or on deputation are prohibited from participation in tenders and execution of works in the different units of BSNL
 - i. The near relatives for this purpose are defined as.
 - a) Members of a Hindu undivided family.
 - b) They are husband and wife.
 - c) The one is related to the other in the manners as father, mother, son(s) & son's wife (daughter in law), Daughter(s) & daughter's husband (son in law), brother(s) & brother's wife, sister(s) & sister's husband (brother in law).

The company or firm or any other person is not permitted to tender for works in BSNL Unit in which his near relative(s) is/are posted. The Unit is defined as SSA/Circle/Chief

Engineer/Chief Archt/Corporate Office for non-executive employees and all SSA in a Circle including Circle Office/Chief Eng./Chief Archt/Corporate office for executive employees (including those called as Gazetted Officers at present). The tenderer should give a certificate that none of his/her such near relative is working in the units as defined above where he is going to apply for tender/work. In case of proprietorship firm certificate will be given by the proprietor, for partnership firm certificate will be given by all the partners and in case of limited company by all the Directors of company. Any breach of these conditions by the company or firm or any other person, the tender/work will be cancelled and earnest money/Security deposit will be forfeited at any stage whenever it is so noticed. The department will not pay any damages to the company or firm or the concerned person. The company or firm or the person will also be debarred for further participation in the concerned unit

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22. **Termination of contract on death of contractor:-** Without prejudice of any of the rights or remedies under this contract, if the contractor dies, the Engineer in Charge on behalf of the BSNL shall have the option of terminating the contract without compensation to the contractor.
