2. The tender will be opened in the chamber of authorized officer in the O/o G.M. BSNL Mandi BA in the presence of tenderers or their authorized representatives who, may wish to be present at their own expense.

Eligibility Criteria: The Prospective Bidder should satisfy following conditions:

a) The experience certificate (as per above) should have been issued by the officer not below the rank of STS officer or tender approving authority in case of BSNL/MTNL/ DOT.

b) The following documents are required:

- 6. Period of contract One year from the date of agreement and extendable further for Twelve months at the same terms and conditions.

7. The Tender, which is not accompanied by requisite Bid security, shall be summarily rejected.

8. 1.0 SEALING AND MARKING OF BIDS

- 1.1 The bid should be submitted as per Clause 3, Section -IA of tender information. Offline envelope should be sealed (packing PVC tape / sealing wax) & online envelope should be digitally sealed.

- 1.1 The tenderer should certify and affix his signature on each and every page of the tender documents and return it along with his tender offer, as a token of his acceptance of each of the conditions specified on each of the conditions specified on each page of the tender document.
- 1.2 Any attempt for negotiation direct or indirect on the part of a tenderer, with the authority to whom he has submitted the tender or the authority who is competent finally to accept it, after he has submitted the tender or endeavors to secure interest for actual or prospective tender or to influence by any means, the tender becomes liable to be excluded for consideration.
- 1.3 The tenderer will be bound by all terms, conditions and specifications as detailed in the tender documents.

Evaluation of L-I, L-II etc. will be done on the basis of quoted rates by the bidder multiplied by the anticipated No. of faulty modules. The anticipated No. of faulty modules may vary at the time of work execution.

3.0 DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED WITH TENDER

- 3.1 One copy of the complete set of tender documents duly filled in and signed on each page and also at every correction/over writing by the tenderer.
- 3.2 Earnest Money deposit amount in the manner specified in the documents.

4.0 EARNEST MONEY:

Earnest Money shall be paid in the shape of Bank Draft in favour of A.O.(Claim) O/o G.M. BSNL, Mandi BA from any Scheduled Bank payable at Mandi.

4.1 No interest shall be allowed on the amount deposited by the tenderer as earnest money. Earnest money of unsuccessful tenderer will be refunded within reasonable time after final decision of the tender without any interest. The earnest money deposit of successful tenderer shall be adjusted towards security deposit for the due fulfillment of the contract, but shall be forfeited if the tenderer fails to deposit initial security deposit and fails to execute the agreements within the period specified and on being called upon to do so after acceptance of the tender or fails to start the work as stipulated in the letter of indent/acceptance.

5.0 SECURITY DEPOSIT

E.M.D. of the successful tenders will be converted into Security deposit. In addition to above 7.5% of the estimated cost of work has to be deposited as security deposit. Hence total security deposit will be 10% of the estimated cost. All the Security deposit will be refunded after six months of the expiry of the contract on production of N.O.C. from field units concerned.

6.0 QUOTATION OF RATES:

Tenderer will quote the rates in Financial Bid in EXCEL FORMAT. The rates should also be quoted in words

7.0 REJECTION OF TENDERS:-

The General Manager Telecom District Mandi reserves the right to accept or reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason what so ever.

- (a) Consideration of any tender not supported by requisite earnest Money Deposit in the manner provided therein.
- (b) Consideration of any tender deficient or incomplete in any of the requisite matters, Particulars or formalities for any reason which shall not be disclosed to tenderer.
- (c) Consideration of any tender offer which change the terms and condition (other than these envisaged in the Tender document sold) altered consideration, specification or time limits set.
- (d) Any or all the tenders received without assigning any reason thereof and will not be bound to accept the lowest tender.
- (e) Incomplete tenders are liable to be rejected.
- (f) Conditional tender will not be accepted.

8.0 VALIDITY

- Tender submitted by tenderer will remain valid for acceptance for a period of 180 day from the date of opening of the tender. The tenderers shall not be entitled during this period of 180 days without the consent in writing of the General Manager Telecom, Mandi to, revoke or cancel his tender or to vary the tenders awarded shall remain valid for a period of one year at the same rates, terms and conditions from the date of agreements. The tender validity may be extended up to one year more within the N.I.T. value or up to 25% extended N.I.T. value on the same rates, terms and conditions by G.M.T.D. Mandi if required.
- In exceptional situation where the requirement is of an emergent nature and it is necessary to continue services from the existing vendor/contractor, the BSNL reserves the right to extend the tender value up to 50% in the running tender/contract at the same rate or rate negotiated (downwardly) with the existing vendor considering the reasonability of rates based on the prevailing market conditions and impact of reduction in duties and taxes etc.

9.0 ACCEPTANCE OF TENDERS AND AWARD OF WORK:-

- The BSNL/officer inviting tenders shall reserve the right at its/his absolute discretion to accept the tenders any or more than one or wholly or in parts without assigning any reason whatsoever, and it shall be binding on the concerned tenderer to supply/work so awarded. The whole work in any sector may be split up and accepted in parts and not entirely if considered expedient by B.SN.L. at his absolute decision.
- 9.1 Tender will be accepted and contract will be finalized only with those tenderers who in the opinion of the General Manager Telecom are having capacity and resources to execute the work assigned in the prescribed time as per the time schedule.

10.0 SIGNING OF THE CONTRACT AGREEMENT:-

The successful tenderer after depositing security deposit shall be required to execute an agreement on a non-judicial stamp paper at his own cost and in the prescribed Performa. In the event of failure of the tenderer to sign the agreement within specified time of being called upon to do so after the acceptance of the tender, or on the event of his failure to start the work as stipulated, the amount of Earnest Money and/or initial security deposit shall stand forfeited to the B.S.N.L. and the acceptance of the tender shall be considered as revoked.

11.0 SETTLEMENT OF CLAIMS FOR LOSSES AND DAMAGES:-

In the matter or settling any claims for losses, damages, cost of expenses to which the BSNL may be put by reasons of default of the contractor referred to above or the article of the agreements, decision of G.M.T.D Mandi in writing will be final. Amount payable to the contractor whether arising out of this particular contract or out of any other transaction of contract whatsoever.

12.0 TERMINATION OF CONTRACT

The G.M.T.D. Mandi, has the option of terminating the contract either partially or wholly at any stage without assigning any reason by giving one month notice in writing to that effect and shall not be liable to pay any compensation to the contractor, whatsoever it may be. **DRK AND ACCEPTANCE TESTING:-**

13.0 WORK AND ACCEPTANCE TESTING:-

The contractor will prepare bills in triplicate for the works executed by him. The work should be accepted by the JTO, SDO (T) & DE (T) of concerned exchanges and then accepted tested by the work order issuing authority

14.0 ARBITRATION

- I. In the event of any question, dispute or difference arising under the agreement or in the connection there with except as to matter the decision of which is specifically provided under the agreement, the same shall be referred to sole arbitration of the CMD, B.S.N.L. or in case his designation is changed or his office is abolished then in such case to the sole .arbitration of the officer for the time being entrusted whether in addition to the function of the CM.D. Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited or by whatever designation such officer may be called (here in after referred to as the said officer) and if the CM.D. or the said officer is unable or unwilling to act as such to the sole arbitration or some other person appointed by the CM.D. or the said officer . the agreement to appoint an arbitrator will be in accordance with the arbitration act, 1996.
- II. There will be no objection that the arbitrator is BSNL's servant or that he has to deal with the matter to which the agreement relates or that in the course of his duties as BSNL's servant he has expressed vies on all or any of the matter under dispute. The award to whom the matter is originally referred being transferred of vacating his office or being unable act for any reasons whatsoever such C.M.D. or the said officer shall appoint other person to act as arbitrator in accordance with terms of the agreement and the person so appointed shall be entitled to proceed from the stage at which it was left out by his predecessors.
- III. The arbitrator may from time to time with the consent of parities enlarge the time for making and publishing the award subject to aforesaid in the arbitration act 1940 and the rules made there under any modification thereof for the time being enforce shell be deemed to apply to the arbitration proceeding under this clause.
- IV. The venue of arbitration proceeding shall be the office of CMD BSNL at New Delhi or such other places as the arbitrator may decide .
- V. If there is any court case in connection with this work, shall be entertained only at Mandi and no other place.

15.0 PENALTY CLAUSE:

- Delay and abandoning of the execution of the Work
- 15.1 All the complaints should be attended and rectified within 48 hours. In case of Exchange/BTS failure, the fault will be reported to contractor through E-Mail/Land line phone and contractor will have to attend the site within six hours.
- 15.2 If the fault is not repairable at site Within 48 hours, the contractor should replace the
 - Module from his imprest stock and telephone exchange/ BTS services should be restored.
- 15.3 In no case, the exchange services should be hampered more than twenty four hours, due to failure of power plant. It should be taken as an essence of the Contract.
- 15.4 In any case, if the above conditions are not met out by the contractor and work not executed within the stipulated period of PO, penalty will be imposed as below:
 - a) Up to 7 days delay, penalty @ Rs. 100-00 per day per PO
 - b) From 8-14 days delay, penalty @ Rs. 200-00 per day per PO
 - c) From 15-21 days delay, penalty @ Rs. 350-00 per day per PO
 - d) From 22-28 days delay, penalty @ Rs. 500-00 per day per PO
 - If the contractor fails to repair the modules up to 4 weeks, the BSNL Mandi is entitled to forfeit the security/performance deposit, terminate the contract and BSNL can also black list the contractor.
- 15.5 In case either the contractor abandon the Work or the contractor is removed either for delay in work or for want of standard quality. If the work is allotted to some other contractor and the excess amount over the proportion amount awarded thus paid the new party will be recovered from the pending bills or from the Security deposit the original contractor.
- 15.6 In case of delay because of BSNL reasons the matter will be referred in writing to the GMTD, Mandi.
- 15.7 If same fault is re occurred in any Power Plant within six Months of repair, it will be repaired free of cost by the contractor.
- 15.8 Contractor will not open any OK module. Faulty modules will be handed over to the contractor by the BSNL official/ Officer only. Contractor will not use any components of good/faulty modules of Power Plants for repair of module under repair. If it is found that components of modules (faulty/good) have been used by the contractor for repair, the cost of the Module will be recovered from the contractor.
- 15.9 If there is loss of revenue to BSNL due to non-attendance/non repair of Modules, BSNL Mandi will be at liberty to recover this from the contractor.
- 15.10 After signing the agreement, the contractor will hand over 1% of the tendered modules in good condition at SDCA H/Q to be used in case of emergency.
- 15.11 In case of emergency (Power supply failure of any node due to Power Plant), BSNL Mandi (SDE/SDO/DE concerned) shall be at liberty to get the work done on any source, not necessarily on the contractor rates, on the cost of the contractor, The contractor shall be liable to make good such loss to BSNL and amount spent.

16. PAYMENT

- The Bill of Contractor will be paid by A.O. (Claim) B.S.N.L. O/o GM BSNL Mandi BA on submission of bills in triplicates through concerned SDO in charge of exchange giving necessary verification certificate countersigned by DET concerned. Bill should bear the agreement number and work order No._____
- 16.1 Work order will be issued by the officer nominated by the GM BSNL Mandi BA on receipt of the requisition from SDO in charge of the exchange duly recommended by DET with reference to agreement No._____

(a) Invoice clearly indicating break up details of composite price i.e. Basic, E.D., Sales Tax, any other Duties and Taxes, Freight/Packing Charges, Service Tax etc.

- (b) Acknowledged Delivery Challan in original.
- (c) Excise gate pass / invoice or equivalent document, if applicable.
- (d) Inspection Certificate of QA(Payable copy in original)
- (e) The sea freight receipt as per the rates approved by the Ministry of Water and Surface Transport, if applicable.
- (f) Proof of payment of Octroi/ entry tax etc., if applicable.

Note: - If the supplier fails to furnish necessary supporting documents i.e. excise/Customs invoices etc. in respect of the Duties/taxes which are CENVAT-able, the amount pertaining to such Duties/Taxes will be deducted from the payment due to the firm.

16.2 The balance payment shall be released within 6 months from the date of supply of the equipment in case there are no damage/shortages. In those cases where such shortages/damages are intimated to the supplier in writing, the balance payment shall be released only after the cases are settled in accordance with the provision of the P.O.

16.3 100% Payment may be made on delivery, provided that an additional Bank Guarantee for an amount equal to Balance Payment % of the value of supplies valid for a minimum period of seven months is furnished by the supplier along with an undertaking that the equipment/stores supplied shall be free from damages/shortages. In case purchaser intimates shortages/ damages in received stores to the supplier in writing, the Bank Guarantee shall be extended without fail by the supplier for a suitable period as requested by the purchaser in writing. Failure to do so shall result in forfeiture of Bank Guarantee. The Bank Guarantee shall be accepted at Circle Head Quarter and shall be released only after the cases are settled in accordance with the provisions available in the Purchase Order/ Tender document.

Note: The actual payment conditions for new products or procurements having installation and AMC services may be decided on case to case basis and incorporated in special conditions of the contract."

17. Technical Specifications:

The Repair contract of SMPS power plant on call basis includes repair of SMPS power plant modules of 25 A, 50 A, &100 A. Addition to repair all the control cards like MCM/Monitoring panel/Digital Power supply cards,PSC card, TEMCO Card, Display Card, Alarm Card, Volt Meter, Ammeter, MCBs etc will be considered as repair of one 25 Amp module.

Power plant modules will be repaired as per the choice of purchaser. The choice of purchaser will be:

- 1. At site of installation (Where Power plant is working).
- 2. At central location Sundernagar (For Mandi SSA)

3. At central location Kullu (For Kullu SSA)

Transportation of module for carrying out central repair i.e. at Sundernagar/Kullu will be borne by the department, whereas for repair at site no transportation charges should be given to supplier/contractor. Bidder must quote separate rate for at site and repair at central site. The decision of choice of repair of module will be of BSNL and contractor must abide by.

The work involved is for providing repair services for 25 Amp, 50 Amp, 100 Amp and MCM/Monitoring panel/Digital Power supply cards SMPS power plant Modules of different make installed at various telephone exchanges and BTSs of Mandi BA.

18. The tenderer signing the tender in case of firms should clearly mention whether they are signing as(1)sole proprietor (2) partner (3) under the power of Attorney (4)Director, Manager or secretary etc. As the case may be copies of document authorizing the tenderer signing the tender on behalf of that company, firms and person should be attached with the tender.

19. I) PURCHASER'S RIGHT TO VARY QUANTITIES

(a) BSNL reserves the right to increase or decrease up to 25% of the quantity of goods and services specified in the schedule of requirements without any change in the unit price or other terms and BSNL Revised Procurement Manual 2012 Page 51 conditions at the time of award of contract.

(b) BSNL also reserves the right for placement of additional order or up to50% of the additional quantities of goods and services contained in the running tender/ contract within a period of twelve months from the date of acceptance of first APO in the tender at the same rate or a rate negotiated (downwardly) with the existing venders considering the reasonability of rates based on prevailing market conditions and the impact of reduction in duties and taxes etc and supplies to be obtained within delivery period scheduled afresh.

c) In exceptional situation where the requirement is of an emergent nature and it is necessary to ensure continued supplies from the existing venders, the purchaser reserves the right to place repeat order up to 100% of the quantities of goods and services contained in the running tender /contract within a period of twelve months from the date of acceptance of first APO in the tender at the same rate or a rate negotiated (downwardly) with the existing venders considering the reasonability of rates based on prevailing market conditions and the impact of reduction in duties and taxes etc. Exceptional situation and emergent nature should be spelt out clearly detailing the justification as well as benefits accrued out of it and loss incurred in case this provision is not invoked and approved by the authority competent to accord administrative and financial approval for the procurement calculated on the basis of total procurement i.e. initial and proposed add-on quantity.

II) PURCHASER'S RIGHT TO ACCEPT ANY BID AND TO REJECT ANY OR ALL BIDS

The Purchaser reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids, at any time prior to award of contract without assigning any reason whatsoever and without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders on the grounds of purchaser's action.

- 20. The accepted rate will be operative for a period of one year the date of signing the agreement. The GM Telecom Distt. Mandi reserves powers to extend or reduce the period. - 21. If damage is done to any property or any person in public then the same will have to be made good by the contractor. Contractor shall follow all workmanship standard prescribed by the BSNL and deliver good quality of work.
- 22. The Contractor shall not engage any BSNL employee (Regular/casual)for getting this job executed. If at any stage it is found doing so, then the G. M. Telecom Distt. Mandi can impose any suitable-penalty even to the extent of termination of the contract leading to the forfeiture of security money.
- 23. The BSNL does not take any responsibility any facility to the labourers employed by the contractor. BSNL will not supply any consumables item. The contractor will be responsible for their safety and in case of any damages to BSNL property or in default the same will be recovered from the bill or adjusted towards security money etc.
- 24. The earnest money will be refunded to the tenderer whose tenders are not accepted in due course in accordance with the rules of the BSNL for which stamped pre-receipt may submitted with the tender.
- 25. The BSNL reserves the right to carry out any work in part or full through BSNL or through any other contractor/agency.
- The BSNL reserves the right to suspend any scheduled item/items temporarily or permanently.

 The contractor shall also measure the earth resistance every 3 months and if found 'not in range', must intimate to concerned SDO in
- 28. The contractor shall also measure the earth resistance every 5 months and 11 found not in range , must infimate to concerned SDO in writing for correction.
- 29. No protective devices will be bypassed by the contractor.
- 30. No spares/components can be used from other modules. If such thing is observed, penalty of Rs.1000-00 per instance shall be levied.

31. The power of declaring a module RNP shall lie with concerned D.E. and modules once made over for repair shall not be declared "RNP' by the contractor.

32. WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION

In every case which by virtue of the provisions of section 12 sub section (91) of the workmen's compensation Act, 1923 Govt. is obliged to any compensation to a workmen employed by the contractor, in execution of the works, BSNL will recover from the contractor the amount of the compensation so paid and without prejudice to the right of the BSNL. Under section 12, sub section (ii) of the said Act, BSNL. Shall be at liberty to recover such amount or any part thereof by deducting it from such amount or any part thereof by deduction it from the security deposit or from any sum due by BSNL to the contractor whether under the contract or otherwise BSNL. shall not be bound to contest any claim made against it under section 12 sub section(1) of the said Act, except on the written request of the contractor and upon his given to BSNL. full security for all costs for which BSNL might become liable in consequence of contesting such claims.

33.0 LABOUR WELFARES

- 33.1 In every case in which by virtue of the provision of the contract labour (regulation and abolition) central rules 1971 BSNL is obliged to pay any amount of wages to a workmen employed by the Contractor in execution of the works or to incur any expenditure in providing welfare and health amenities required to be provided under the above said act and the rules under clause 1'9 to 10 and 20 of pwd-8 or under the C.P.W.D Contractor Labour regulations or under the rules framed by Govt. from time to time for the protection of health and sanitary arrangement for workers employed by C.P.W.D. Contractor's Govt. expenditure so incurred and without prejudice to right of the Govt. under section 20 sub section (2) and without prejudice to right of the Govt. under section 20 sub section (2) and without prejudice to right of the Govt. shall be at liberty to recover such amount or any sum due by BSNL. to the contractor whether under the contract or otherwise BSNL shall not be bound to contest any claim made against it under section 30, subsection (1) of the said act, except on the written request of the contractor and upon which given to BSNL. Full security for all costs for which BSNL might become liable in consequences of contesting such claims.
 - 33.2 Any failure to fulfill this requirement shall attract the panel provision of this contract arising out of the resultant non execution of the work.

33.3 No labour below the age of 18 year shall be employed on the work.

34. Fair Wages:

- a. The contractor shall pay to labour employed by him either directly or through sub contractor, wages not less than fair wages as defined in the CPWD contractors labour regulations or as the provisions of the contractor labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, 1970 and the contract labour (R&A) central rule 1971 wherever applicable.
- **b.** The contractor shall not withstanding the provisions of any contract to contrary clause to be paid fair wages to labour indirectly engaged on the work, including with the said work, as if the labour had been immediately employed by him.
- c) In respect of all labour directly or indirectly in the works for performance of the contractors part of the contractor shall comply with or cause to be complied with the central public works department contractor's labour regulation made by Govt. from time to time in regard to payment of wages, wage period deduction from wages books or wages slips, publication or scale of wages and other terms of employment inspection and submission of periodical returns and all other matter of the like nature or as per the provisions to the contract labour (R& A) Act, 1970 where applicable.
- d) The G.M.T.D., Mandi or his subordinate official concerned shall have the right to deduct from the money due to the contractor any sum required or estimated to be required for making good the loss suffered by a worker or workers by reasons of non fulfillment of the condition of the contract for the benefit of the workers nonpayment of wages or of deduction made from his or their wages which are not justified by their terms of the conduct or non observance of the regulations.

Continental's labour Regulation without prejudice to his right to claim indemnity from his subcontractors.

35. OTHER LABOUR WELFARE MEASURES

- 35.1 The contractor shall implement the labour welfare measures enunciated in clause 19B, 19C, 19E, 19G, 19H, 19L & 19J of the condition contract in the PW 8.
- 35.2 The contractor shall also follow the safety method enunciated in the C.P.W.D. safety code.
- 35.3 The contractor shall comply with all the provision of the minimum wages Act, 1948 contract labour (R & A) Act, 1970 and the rules framed and other labour laws affecting contract labour that may be brought into force from time to time.
- 36. Even during the arbitration the work cannot be stayed because it pertains to the essential public utility service the BSNL reserves the right to get the work done by other agencies even at higher rates and the difference of the cost will be deducted from the contractors pending bills or security money as the case may be.
- 37. If the contractor refuses for executing any specified work, the BSNL reserves the right to get the work done by other agencies even at higher rates and the difference of the cost will be deducted from contractors pending bills or security money as the case may be.

______, the terms and conditions herein contained in tender document whereas the contractor has deposited security for Rs ------- (Rupees ------ only) vide No. ------ dated 2022 for satisfactory fulfillment of the contract. A bank guarantee of Rs. ------ will be given by the contractor as additional security against this contract. The whole amount of security deposit is to be released within six months on satisfactorily completion of contract work and final acceptance by the BSNL and whereas no interest will be paid by the BSNL for the said security.

Now in the presence of witnesses, it is hereby agreed and declared by and between the parties is present as follows.

- 1.0 It is a new work initially contract will be for three months if there is no complaints from the field during these three months then it will be automatically extended up to one year or as per tender document.
- 3.0 The Contractor shall promptly carry out all the work referred to above whenever called upon by the BSNL or by any of be persons mentioned in clause (1) hereof and within the time as will be specified to him by the BSNL or any of the persons mentioned in Clause (1) hereof at the time of placing work order for each work. The time allowed for completing the work as entered in the work order shall strictly be adhered by the contractor and timely completion of work should be deemed to be the essence of the contract in the part of the contract.

If the contractor fails to complete the work as given in the work order within the time specified with work order, penalty or recovery at the following rates shall be imposed including further necessary action

I A penalty of 10% of the approved rate of Modules of power plants repair will be imposed per day in case of failure to carry out the work exceeding the period given in work order as above subject to the condition maximum penalty will be of 20% (Twenty percent) of the work cost of work order and will be deducted from bills/ security deposit of the contractor.

- 5.0 If the contractor shall desire an extension of time for completion of work on the ground of his having been unavoidably hindered in its execution, or another ground he shall apply in writing to the DET concerned within three days from the date of such hindrance on account of which he desire such extension as aforesaid and the DET concerned shall in his opinion (which shall be final) where exists reasonable ground therefore grant such extension of time, if any, as may be deemed necessary or proper by him. The extension letter should be recommended by the concerned SDO & C/S by D.E.T. concerned with appropriate reasons for extension.
- 6.0 The contractor shall execute all the item of work mentioned in the work order for each work in the most efficient workmen like manner both as regards materials and otherwise in every respect in strict accordance with the instruction given to him from time to time by the officers mentioned in clause (1) hereof. - 7.0 The contractor hereby declares that the spare parts for repair of Modules along with control panels of power plants under this agreement shall be of the best quality and hereby warranty for trouble free working of repaired instrument for SIX months after repair of the faulty instrument.
- 8.0 The contractor shall also supply the requisite number of workmen with means and materials as well as tools, appliances etc. required for the proper repair of faulty Modules of power plants within the time prescribed in the work order.
- 9.0 Contractor shall abide by the rules, terms and conditions and specifications laid down in the instructions and guidelines to tenderers, conditions of contract specification mentioned in tender document. This agreement and such other rules and regulations as may be framed from time to time by the GM BSNL Mandi BA or his nominees.

 - (b) On inspection of the work of the contractor and to take such part thereof as shall be unexecuted out of his hand and give it to another contractor to complete and in case of defects discovered subsequently to have the defects repaired and removed by another contractor or get the work complete by departmentally. In both cases any expenses with may be incurred in excess of the amount which would have been paid to the contractor if the whole work had been properly executed by him (of the amount of such excess the certificate in writing of any of officers mention in clause (I) hereof shall be final and conclusive) shall be borne and paid by the contractor and may be deducted from any money due to him by the BSNL under this contract or otherwise, or from the security Deposit or sufficient part there of or otherwise recovered from him in both cases if the expenses incurred by the BSNL are less than the amount payable to the contractor at his agreement rates, the difference should not be paid to the contractor.
- 19.0 BSNL shall be entitled to terminate this contract without assigning any reasons by giving to the contractor one calendar month notice its intention to do so and on the expire of said period of notice the contract shall come to an end without prejudice to any right or remedy that may accrued to either party by reason of any antecedent breach of any terms thereof. Such notice may be signed on behalf of BSNL by any of the officers mentioned in the clause (I) hereof
- 20.0 In the event any of courses mentioned in clause (15) or (16) being adopted the contractor shall have no claim for compensation for any loss sustained by him by reason of his having purchased or procured any materials or entered into any engagements or made any advance on account of or with a view to the execution of the work or the performance thereof.
- 21.0 If the contractor shall die before the expiry of this contract the BSNL or any of the officers mentioned in clause (1) hereof may at his option either immediately determine this contract or require the heirs or local representatives of the contractor to carry out the same for such period not exceeding three calendar months as BSNL and the said officers may require.
 - 22.0 Any notice require to be given under these presents may be given either personally to the contractor under acknowledgment or by posting letter addressed to the contractor at the said address and shall be deemed to be served at the time of such delivery or at the time of leaving the same with the contractor or in the case or posting at the time when the letter would have reached the contractor in the ordinary course of post.
- 23.0 The GM BSNL Mandi BAbe at liberty by notice in writing to the contractor to rescind the contract in any and every of the following case (stated in sub Para 'a' to 'j') and the contractor shall there upon pay to the BSNL in addition to any sum or sums of money which the contractor may be liable to pay under the provisions herein before stated such as the GM BSNL Mandi BA may decide to be reasonable compensation for the loss or inconvenience caused. The amount of sum for such breach on the part of the contractor will be fixed by the GM BSNL Mandi BAand shall be final and conclusive against the contractor.
 - a. The contractor will submit for examination in the office of GM BSNL Mandi BA its books of account and all concerned paper maintained by it in this connection within 15 (fifteen) days from the date of its being called upon to do so, if the contractor fails to do so then GM BSNL Mandi BA or any other person authorized by him.
 - b. If any fraud or fraudulent motive is detected in the contractor's action with the BSNL and/ or GM BSNL Mandi BAor any other person authorized by him.
 - c. If the contractor demands undue charges not stipulated in this contract and/ or.
 - d. If any persons connected with the BSNL or any official drawing salary from the BSNL becomes in any way interested in this contract and/ or.
 - e. If the contractor himself or any of his servant be guilty of fraud or attempted fraud in connection with the contract offer any bribe or gratuity to any person connected with the BSNL or to any official drawing salary from the BSNL and/ or.
 - f. If the contractor employs any outside agent or sublets the contract or any right to payment there under without the consent in writing of the GM BSNL Mandi BAand/ or.
 - g. If in the event of any deduction being made from the contractor's security deposit the contractor fails to make good the amount of such deduction within the time herein before specified and/ or.

- h. If the contractor becomes insolvent or applies for relief as insolvent debtor and /or in case a contractor is a company and it is wound up or in case the contractor in a partnership firm when it is dissolved or reconstituted and/or GM BSNL Mandi BAor any other person authorized by him.
- i. If the contractor makes default in or fails to comply with any of the terms and conditions set forth in this contract and/ or GM BSNL Mandi BAor any other person authorized by him.
- j. If the contractor's work is found unsatisfactory in the opinion of GMTD Mandi/ DET/ site officer.

All disputes, differences and question arising out of or incidental to this agreement or in any way touching or concerning this agreement or the subject matter thereof of the respective rights, duties or liabilities of the parties under or in respect of this agreement (except the decision thereof is herein before otherwise expressly provided for) shall be referred to sole arbitration of CMD BSNL New Delhi or any person nominated by him, to the sole arbitration of any person appointed by the officer who for the time being is entrusted whether or not in addition to other function with the function of CMD BSNL New Delhi by whatsoever designation such officer may be called thereafter referred to as " the said officer".

There will be no objection to any such appointment that the person appointed is a BSNL servant. If however, the arbitrator is a BSNL servant, he will not be one who had an opportunity to deal with the matter to which this agreement relates, or that in the course of his duty as such BSNL servant he has expressed views on all or any of the matter in dispute or differences. The arbitrator, while acting as such arbitrator shall not be bound to take any oral or documentary evidence and shall be at liberty to take such evidences as he may in his absolute discretion think proper and that he will be at liberty to proceed with the matter and hear parties in the absence of any or some of them or there legal and/ or technical advisor without being liable for a misconduct within the meaning of the provisions of sections 30 of the Indian Arbitration Act in this behalf. In the event of such arbitrator to whom the matter is originally referred being transferred or another person to act as a arbitrator in accordance with the terms of agreement. such persons shall be entitled to proceed with the reference from the stage at which it was left by predecessor.

- 24.1 Subject to aforesaid, the Indian Arbitrator Act 1940 and the rules made there under and any modifications thereof for the time being in force shall be deemed to apply to the arbitration proceedings under this clause. The contractor must move for appointment of arbitrators in case of disputes of payments with the BSNL within six months from the date of completion of work and after six months such cases will not be entertained by the BSNL. The contractor should address to the CMD BSNL for appointment of arbitration. The venue of arbitration will be decided by the sole arbitrator.
- 24.2 Upon every and any reference as a aforesaid the assessments of costs incidental to the reference and award respectively shall be in the sole discretion of the sole arbitrator to avoid delay in settlement of cases.
- 25 BSNL shall have the right to cause an audit and technical examination of the works and final bills of the contractor including all supporting vouchers, abstract etc to be made after payment of the final bill and if as a result of such audit and technical examination any sum is found to have been overpaid in respect of any work done by the contractor under the contract or any work claimed by him to have been done by him under the contract and found not have been executed, the contractor shall be liable to refund the amount of overpayment and shall be lawful for BSNL to recover the same from him or in any other manner legally permissible, and if it is found that the contractor was paid less than what was due to him under the contract in respect of any work executed by him under it, the amount of such underpayment shall be duly paid by BSNL to the contractor.
- 26 The term and condition in addition to above as mentioned in the tender document will also be applied for this agreement. The tender document and acceptance letter will also be the part of this agreement. IN WITNESS WHEREOF the parties' presents have herein to set their respective hands and seals the day and year first above written.
