. **Submission of Tender**:-The tender is to be dropped in tender box kept in the O/o GMTD Shimla up to 1430 hrs of date of opening of tender.

2 Eligibility Condition: The prospective bidders should satisfy following conditions

He should have completed similar work in BSNL/MTNL/PSU/Govt. department as per detail given below during last seven years ending last day of month previous to one in which the tenders are invited:

I. Three similar completed works each costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of estimated cost. OR

II. Two similar completed works each costing not less than the amount equal to 50% of estimated cost. OR

III. One similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 80% of estimated cost.

Class IV & above Electrical Enlisted contractor OR authorized service dealer of DG set (Make of the battery must be specified e.g. Exide/ Standard Furukawa/ AMCO/Pacesetter/ Prestolite / Amara Raja Standard /Crompton graves / Hitachi/ Kirloskar etc.)

The Experience certificate should be issued by an officer not below than the rank of STS or Equivalent.

The payment of Bid Security (EMD) will be accepted in the form of crossed demand draft on any scheduled bank in favour of "*Accounts Officer (Cash), BSNL, Office of the General Manager Telecom Distt, SHIMLA*", payable at SHIMLA. The completed bids addressed to <u>AGM</u> (Operation), O/O G.M.T.D. SHIMLA must reach on due date/time. If the date of opening of the tender happens to be a holiday, the tender will be opened on the next working day.

The tender, which is not accompanied by the requisite Bid Security, shall be summarily rejected. In_addition to this tender document not accompanied with the cost of bid document (in case of document downloaded from the website) will summarily be rejected. The downloaded "Tender Document" in which rates are quoted should be properly bound and sealed Loose/spiral bound submission shall be rejected out-rightly. In case of any correction/addition/alteration/omission in tender document, the bid shall be treated as nonresponsive and summarily be rejected. The tenderer shall furnish a declaration to this effect that no addition/deletion/correction have been made in the tender document submitted and it is identical to the tender document appearing in the website Tender will not be accepted/ received after expiry date and time. GMTD SHIMLA reserves the right to reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason whatsoever.

SECTION -II **INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE BIDDER**

1. **DEFINITIONS**

- (A) "The BSNL." means the Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited
- (B) "The Bidder" means the individual or firm who participates in the tender and submits its bid.
- (C) "DEA" means Diesel Engine Alternator.

2. ELIGIBLE BIDDERS

As per Clause 7

3. COST OF BIDDING

The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of the bid. GMTD SHIMLA will, in no case, be responsible or liable for these costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the biding process.

4. AMENDMENT OF BID DOCUMENTS

- **4.1** At any time, prior to the date of submission of Bids, the BSNL may, for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective bidder, modify bid documents by amendments.
- 4.2 The amendments shall be notified in writing or by FAX to all prospective bidders on the address intimated at the time of purchase of the bid document from the BSNL and these amendments will be binding on them.
- 4.3 In order to afford prospective bidders a reasonable time to take the amendment into account in preparing their bids, the BSNL may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of bids suitably.

5. BID FORM

The bidder shall complete the bid form and appropriate Price Schedule furnished in the Bid Documents as per section VI

6. BID PRICES

6.1 The bidder shall give the total composite price inclusive of all Levies & Taxes except service tax which will be payable extra as applicable, under the contract as per the price schedule given in Section VI. . The offer shall be firm in Indian Rupees.

- 6.2 The price quoted by the bidder shall remain fixed during the entire period of contract and shall not be subject to variation on any account. A bid submitted with an adjustable price quotation will be treated as non - responsive and rejected.
- 6.3 The prices quoted by the bidder shall be in sufficient detail to enable the BSNL to arrive at the price of items offered.

7. DOCUMENTS ESTABLISHING BIDDER'S ELIGIBILITY AND QUALIFICATION

- 7.1 Bid should be submitted properly sealed with sealing Wax /PVC tape. The bid will consist of two sealed envelopes super scribed as "**Pre Qualification Bid" and** "**Financial Bid".** The envelope super scribed as Pre Qualification Bid will consist of:
 - i) Complete signed Bid form excluding financial bid section.
 - ii) Demand Draft of bid security in favour of "Accounts Officer (Cash) BSNL % GMTD SHIMLA" payable at SHIMLA.
 - iii) Proof of experience. The experience certificate should be duly attested.
 - iv) The prospective bidder should have valid trade tax registration certificate with government
 - v) Latest Income Tax Return & PAN card.
 - vi) Original power of Attorney duly notarized in case person other than the tenderer has signed the tender documents.
 - vii) Registration of firm, partnership deed, in case of partnership firm.
 - viii) DEMAND DRAFT for depositing of payment of cost of document has to be supplied along with the bid in case bid document downloaded from

website. In case of failure to supply this proof, the bid will be rejected.

- ix) Declaration as per NIT in respect of downloaded document that nothing has been tampered.
- x) The bidder should submit following details for e-payment:-

 - Also attach the copy of cancelled blank cheque of the above mentioned A/c.
- xi) An undertaking to be submitted by the bidder about the genuineness and correctness of all documents and certificates submitted along with the bid

The bidder will verify the genuineness and correctness of all documents and certificates, including experience/performance certificates issued either by the bidder or any other firm/associate before submitting them in the bid. The onus of providing genuineness of the submitted documents would rest with the bidder

The second envelope superscribed as Financial Bid should contain the price schedule given in section VI. Both the envelopes should further be sealed in a large envelope, superscribed with "Replacement of batteries for various existing DEA Sets in Exchange/BTS sites under Shimla SSA" addressed to AGM (Operation) % GMTD SHIMLA.

- 7.2 Tender without any of the above document is be liable for rejection.
- 7.3 Envelope superscribed, as "Pre Qualification Bid" will be opened first by the Tender opening committee (TOC).
- 7.4 Financial bid will be opened by the TOC in respect of those bidders whose prequalification bid is found to be in order. Other financial bids will be returned to bidders without opening.
- 7.5 A gazetted officer from Central/State Govt must attest all the documents. Unattested documents shall not be entertained.
- 7.6 Tender will be opened in the presence of those bidders/their representatives who may wish to be present at their own cost.
- 7.7 Only one person either bidder or his representative will be permitted to present while opening of the bids.

- 7.8 If the documents of 1st and 2nd envelopes are found interchanged, the bid will be rejected.
- 7.9 In case of holiday on dates given above, next working day will be treated for the purpose.
- 7.10 Any bid received by the BSNL after the scheduled time for submission of bids shall be rejected and returned unopened to the bidder.

8. BID SECURITY

- 8.1 The bidder shall furnish, as part of his bid, a bid security as per NIT.
- 8.2 The bid security is required to protect the BSNL against the risk of bidder's conduct, which would warrant the forfeiture of bid security pursuant to Para 8.6.
- 8.3 The bid security shall be in the form of a bank draft issued by a scheduled bank in favour of "Accounts Officer (Cash), BSNL O/o GMTD SHIMLA", payable at SHIMLA
- 8.4 A bid not secured in accordance with Para 8.1 & 8.3 shall be rejected by the BSNL being non-responsive at the bid opening stage.
- 8.5 The bid security of the unsuccessful bidder will be discharged/returned as promptly as possible as but not later than 30 days after the expiry of the period of the bid validity prescribed by the BSNL pursuant to clause 9.
- 8.6 The bid security may be forfeited:
- (a) If the bidder withdraws his bid during the period of bid validity specified by the bidder in the Bid form or
- (b) In the case of successful bidder, if the bidder fails:
- (i) To sign the contract in accordance with clause 17 or
- (ii) To furnish Security deposit in accordance with clause 16.
- (c) In both the above cases, i.e. 8.6 (a) & (b), the bidder will not be eligible to participate in the tender for same item for one year from the date of issue of acceptance letter. The bidder will not approach the court against the decision of BSNL in this regard.
- 8.7 He should hold a valid Service Tax Registration in favour of the firm.

9. PERIOD OF VALIDITY OF BIDS

- 9.1 Bid shall remain valid for 150 days from the date of opening of bids. Any bid with shorter validity period will be rejected.
- 9.2 In exceptional circumstances, the GMTD SHIMLA may request the consent of the bidder for an extension to the period of bid validity. The request and the response thereto shall be made in writing. The bid security provided under clause 8 shall also be suitably extended. The bidder may refuse the request without forfeiting his bid security. A bidder accepting the request and granting extension will not be permitted to modify his bid.

10. CLARIFICATION OF BIDS

To assist in the examination, evaluation and comparison of bids, the GMTD SHIMLA may, at its discretion ask the bidder for the clarification of its bid. The request for the clarification and the response shall be in writing. However, no post bid clarification at the initiative of the bidder shall be entertained.

11. PRELIMINARY EVALUATION

- 11.1 BSNL shall evaluate the bids to determine whether they are complete, whether any computational errors have been made, whether required sureties have been furnished, whether the documents have been properly signed and whether the bids are generally in order.
- 11.2 Arithmetical errors shall be rectified on the following basis. If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price shall prevail and the BSNL shall correct the total price. If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail. If the supplier does not accept the correction of the errors, his bid shall be rejected.
- 11.3 Prior to the detailed evaluation pursuant to clause 12, the BSNL will determine the substantial responsiveness of each bid to the Bid Document. For purposes of these clauses, a substantially responsive bid is one, which confirms to all the terms and conditions of the Bid Documents without material deviations. The GMTD SHIMLA determination of bid's responsiveness shall be based on the contents of the bid itself without recourse to extrinsic evidence.
- 11.4 A bid, determined as substantially non-responsive will be rejected by the BSNL and shall not subsequent to the bid opening be made responsive by the bidder by correction of the non-conformity.
- 11.5 The GMTD SHIMLA may waive any minor infirmity or non-conformity or irregularity in a bid, which doesn't constitute a material deviation, provided such waiver, doesn't prejudice or affect the relative ranking of any bidder.

12. EVALUATION AND COMPARISON OF SUBSTANTIALLY RESPONSIVE BIDS

- 12.1 The BSNL shall evaluate in detail and compare the bids previously determined to be substantially responsive pursuant to clause 11.
- 12.2 The evaluation and comparison of responsive bids shall be done on the price of the goods offered inclusive of all Taxes as indicated in Price Schedule in Section VI of the Bid Document.

13. AWARD OF CONTRACT

The BSNL shall consider placement of acceptance letter only on those eligible bidders whose offers have been found technically, commercially and financially acceptable. The GMTD SHIMLA reserves the right to counter offers price(s) against price(s) quoted by any bidder.

14. **RIGHT TO VARY QUANTITIES**

BSNL will have the right to increase up to 25% of the quantity of work specified in the schedule of requirements without any change in the unit price or other terms and conditions at the time of award of contract. However the quantity can be decreased as per discretion of GMTD Shimla.

15. RIGHT TO ACCEPT ANY BID AND TO REJECT ANY OR ALL BIDS

The BSNL reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids, at any time prior to award of contract without assigning any reason whatsoever and without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders on the grounds of BSNL's action.

16. ISSUE OF ACCEPTANCE LETTER

- 16.1 The issue of an acceptance letter shall constitute the intention of the GMTD SHIMLA to enter into contract with the bidder.
- 16.2 The bidder shall within 14 days of issue of the acceptance letter give his acceptance along with security deposit (which is 7.5 % of the total cost of job).& EMD taken will also be converted into Security deposit i.e. total security deposit will by 10% of the contract value.

17. SIGNING OF CONTRACT

- 17.1 The issue of Acceptance Letter shall constitute the award of contract on the bidder.
- 17.2 Upon the successful bidder furnishing security pursuant to clause 16, the earnest money will be converted into security deposit with AO (cash) % GMTD SHIMLA. Total S.D. will be 10 % of the tendered cost.
- 17.3 The work order will be issued from this office .

18. ANNULMENT OF AWARD

- 18.1 Failure of the successful bidder to comply with the requirement of clause 17 shall constitute sufficient ground for the annulment of the award and the forfeiture of the bid security in which event the GMTD SHIMLA may make the award to any other bidder at the discretion of the BSNL or call for new bids. BSNL reserves the right to disqualify the tenderer for a suitable period that habitually failed to execute the work within stipulated time.
- 19. BSNL reserves the right to blacklist a bidder for a suitable period in case he fails to honour his bid without sufficient grounds or does not complete the work assigned to the specification.
- 20 Extension of tender Period:-

GMTD SHIMLA reserves the right to extend the tender under same term & conditions for next one year. Tender can be extended on the written request of successful bidder who executed the work successfully. First time extension will be given for Three months & if necessary it can be extended up to one year.

SECTION-III

GENERAL (COMMERCIAL) CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

DEFINATIONS:

1. **PERFORMANCE SECURITY**

- 1.1 The supplier shall furnish balance security to the BSNL SHIMLA for an amount equal to 7.5% of the contract value 14 days from the date of acceptance of tender in shape of Bank Guarantee in favour of AO (cash) % GMTD BSNL SHIMLA.& his EMD will also be converted into security deposit. Total performance security will be 10% of the contract value .Total performance security can be deposited in the shape of bank guarantee also & in such case EMD will be refunded.
- 1.2 The proceeds of the security shall be payable to the BSNL SHIMLA as compensation for any loss resulting from the bidder failure to complete its obligations under the contract.
- 1.3 The BSNL will discharge the performance security after completion of the tenderer performance obligations under the contract.
- 1.4 The period of work performance security will be 18 months from the date of signing of agreement
- 1.5 No interest shall be payable on the security deposit or any amount payable to the contractor under the contract.

2. CONTRACT: -

CONTRACT means the documents forming the tender and acceptance thereof and the formal agreement executed between BSNL herein after referred as COMPANY and the CONTRACTOR together with the documents referred to therein including the conditions of CONTRACT, the specifications and instructions issued from time to time by the GMTD SHIMLA and all these documents taken together shall be deemed to form one contract and shall be complimentary to one another.

In the CONTRACT, following expressions shall unless where the context otherwise required have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them.

- (a) The 'CONTRACTOR' shall mean the individual or firm or Company whether incorporated or not undertaking the work, and shall included the legal personal representative or such individuals or the persons composing such firm or company or the successors of such firm or company on the successors of such firm or company and the permitted assignees or such individual or firm or firms or company.
- (b) The CMD means CMD BSNL and his successors.
- (c) The COMPANY will mean the Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited.
- (d) All references of BSNL:
- *i) General Manager Telecom. Distt.*
- ii) Addl. General Manager
- iii) AGM/ Divisional Engineer.
- iv) SDO/SDE
- v) Junior Telecom Officer.
- vi) Chief Accounts Officer.
- vii) Accounts Officer.
 - In various clauses shall be taken to mean:

BSNL: Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited.

i to vii) The Officers, in their respective grades/groups employed in the BSNL by whatever designations are assigned to them from time to time and who may be In charge of testing, acceptance of work, maintenance of accounts and disposal of claims, from time to time includes their successors in office. Word imparting the singular number includes the plural number and vice-versa.

3 PERIOD OF VALIDITY

Rates should be quoted inclusive of all taxes except service tax and will remain fixed during contract period.

4. OTHER CONDITIONS OF THE CONTRACT:-

4.1 GMTD SHIMLA shall award work to the contractor.

- 4.2 If the contractor shall desire an extension of time for completion of work on some ground the extension shall be allowed by GMTD SHIMLA. Penalty as per the clause 8 will be charged in all such case except where is delay is due to BSNL reason or any unavoidable circumstances.
- 4.3 If the contractor fails to comply with the work within the period specified in the work order as per terms & condition of the agreement/tender. It will be treated refusal of work order unless and otherwise extended vide 4.2

5. REFUND OF SECURITY DEPOSIT:

- 5.1 The security deposit or a part thereof or such balance thereof if any shall be paid back to the successful bidder after a satisfactory warranty period of six months from the date of satisfactory completion of work. The Bidder shall remain liable to the BSNL in respect of any shortfall or discharge liability not withstanding return or security deposit or any part thereof.
- 5.2 No interest will be payable on the Earnest money or the security deposit or the amount payable to the contractor under this contract
- No demand shall be made by the contractor or any other persons on his behalf 5.3 or in his place for refund of security deposit till all claims due to and by the BSNL are finally settled after the formation of the contract and the contractor agreed to furnish a no demand certificate to the GMTD SHIMLA in six month s from the date of final settlement of accounts failing which the GMTD SHIMLA authorized to settle the accounts finally and no claims from the contractor will be entertained subsequently. The GMTD SHIMLA is also authorized to hold in abeyance the refund of said security deposit for at least six months from the date of receipt of no demand certificate from the contractor. During the stipulated period of the contract no assignment in full or in part of security deposit, or of the bill payable by the GMTD SHIMLA shall be made by the contractors in favour of any other person or party. If any such assignment is made the same shall not be binding upon the GMTD SHIMLA, provided that if any such assignment is made after the formation of the contract duty before the refund of the security deposit or payment of the bills, the same shall be done in writing according to legal procedure and with the provisions and consent in writing of the GMTD SHIMLA.

6 SETTLEMENT OF CLAIMS FOR LOSSES AND DAMAGE

In the matter of settling any claims for losses, damages cost or expenses to which the BSNL may be put by reason of default of the contractor referred to above or the article of the agreements, decision of GMTD SHIMLA in writing will be final. The GMTD SHIMLA is also authorized by the contract to retain and set off the amount payable to the contractor whether arising out of this particular contract or out of any other transaction of contract whatsoever.

7 TERMINATION OF CONTRACT

The GMTD SHIMLA has the option of terminating the contract either partly or wholly at any stage without assigning any reasons by giving one month's notice in writing to that effect and shall not be liable to pay compensation to the contractor therefore. The GMTD SHIMLA will be final judge as the quality of material maintained and his decision will be binding on the contractor.

8 PENALTY FOR DELAY IN COMPLETION OF WORK

The completion of work within time specified in work order shall be deemed to be most important aspect of the contract on the part of the contractor and shall be reckoned from the next day of the issue of the work order. An amount equal to 0.33% of the bill per day shall be deducted from the bill in case of delay in completion of the work subject to maximum 10% of the value of the work against the work order. Time period shall be normally 7 days, however it will be decided by work order issuing authority on the basis of quantum of work.

9. INSPECTION.

- 9.1 The purchaser or his representative shall have the right to inspect and test the goods for their conformity to specifications. The contractor shall provide all reasonable facilities and assistance like testing instruments and other test gadgets at no charge to the purchase. If applicable.
- 9.2 If any inspected or tested goods fail to conform to the specifications the purchaser can reject the item and the supplier shall either replace the rejected goods or make all the alterations necessary to meet specifications free of cost to the purchaser. If applicable.

9.3 Notwithstanding the pre-supply test and inspections prescribed in clause 9.1 and 9.2 above, the items in receipt in the purchaser[®] s premises will also be tested and if any equipment or part is found defective, the same shall be replaced free of all cost to the purchaser. If applicable.

9.4 Nothing is in clause 9 shall in any way release the Contractor from any warranty or other contractual obligations under this contract. If applicable.

10. PAYMENT TERMS

10.1 Payment of bills will be made as under: -

a) Payment of shall be made after submission of the bill & receipt of certificate of successful completion/supply of work. Contractor will submit his bills to AGM (Opn) after certifying the work as satisfactory by SDO/DET concerned. 10% payment will be released only after expiry of warranty period of one year.

- b) Taxes at the prevailing rates will be deducted from the bills duly completed.
- 10.2 The rates once approved will not be enhanced in any circumstances. In case the tenderer shows his inability to carry out work, the same will be got done from other agencies and the amount paid in excess of approved rate will be recovered from the tenderers pending bills/security/performance guarantee.
- 10.3 The GMTD SHIMLA has the right to deduct any amount from the bill, as he may consider reasonable for the unsatisfactory execution of work.
- 10.4 The payment will be made by cheque/RTGS.
- 10.5 No advance payment will be made.
- 10.6 The contractor will not be permitted to sublet the work to other agencies on commission basis. In such circumstances if it is found that the work has been Sublette, the earnest money, security and performance guarantee of the tenderer will be forfeited and no further work will be allotted to him.

- 10.7 If any of the information furnished by the tenderer is found to be incorrect the contract is liable to be terminated without notice and the earnest money and security and performance guarantee deposit is liable to be forfeited.
- 10.8 BSNL will also reserves the right to forfeit earnest money and security and performance guarantee if the tenderer on /after acceptance of the contract fails to comply with any of the terms and conditions set out in tender or agreement. In such circumstance the right of cancellation the contract rests with BSNL.
- **10.9** That in the event of tenderer being adjudged insolvent or otherwise legally in capable of fulfilling this contract. GMTD SHIMLA shall have power to terminate the contract immediately without giving any notice to the tenderer and earnest money and security will be forfeited.
- **10.10** The contractor shall abide by all statutory obligations as applicable.

11. **ARBITRATION**

- 11.1 In the event of any question, dispute or difference arising under this agreement or in connection there-with (except as to the matters, the decision to which is specifically provided under this agreement), the same shall be referred to the sole arbitration of the CGMT HP Circle SHIMLA. The powers to appoint an arbitrator will be in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996. There will be no objection to any such appointment on the ground that the arbitrator is a Government Servant or that he has to deal with the matter to which the agreement relates or that in the course of his duties as a Government Servant he has expressed his views on all or any of the matters in dispute. The award of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties to the agreement. In the event of such an arbitrator to whom the matter is originally referred, being transferred or vacating his office or being unable to act for any reason whatsoever, the CGMT HP Circle SHIMLA or the said officer shall appoint another person to act as an arbitrator in accordance with terms of the agreement and the person so appointed shall be entitled to proceed from the stage at which it was left out by his predecessors. The matter is to be referred for arbitration within six months from date of submission of final claim if dispute arise.
- 11.2 The arbitrator may from time to time with the consent of both the parties enlarge the time frame for making and publishing the award. Subject to the aforesaid, Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and the rules made there under, any modification thereof for the time being in force shall be deemed to apply to the arbitration proceeding under this clause.
- 11.3 The venue of the arbitration proceeding shall be the office of the CGMT HP Circle SHIMLA or such other places as the arbitrator may decide.

12 SET OFF

Any sum of money due and payable to the contractor (including security deposit refundable to him) under this contract may be appropriated by the BSNL or any other person(s) contracting through the BSNL and set off the same against any claim of the BSNL or such other person or person(s) for payment of a sum of money arising out of this contract or under any other contract made by the supplier with the BSNL or such other person(s) contracting through the BSNL.

13. GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- 13.1 Rates are to be quoted in the prescribed Performa at section VI.

18. **Delivery**
